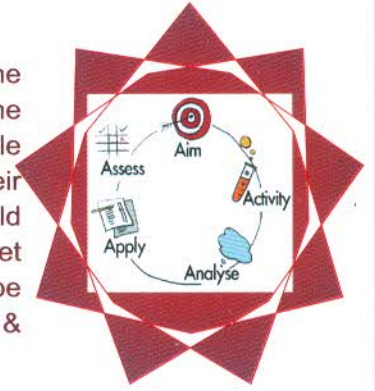

INVESTITURE CEREMONY

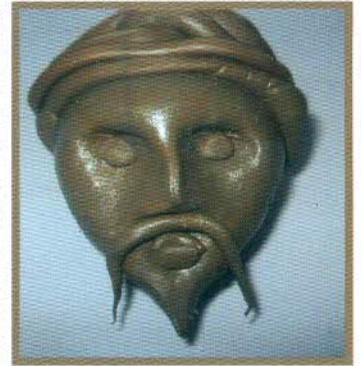
